FWA Orlando Writers Conference plans 2006 literary event

ORLANDO – Tim Dorsey and literary agent Kate McKean are among the talented presenters scheduled to appear at the 2nd annual Orlando Writers Conference on Saturday, Feb. 25, 2006, at the Maitland Arts Center.

Popular Florida mystery novelist Tim Dorsey will deliver one of two keynote addresses. McKean, of Dystel and Goderich Literary Management in New York, will speak to the conference on how to pitch a manuscript to an agent. She will also be available throughout the day to interview with individual writers and to hear pitches.

The conference offers two workshop tracks, one focusing on the craft of writing, the other on business aspects of the profession. The daylong event is for published authors as well as emerging writers of every age and skill level, working in all genres and forms.

The Florida Writers Association (FWA) is sponsoring the conference, which will be held from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. The cost is \$39 for FWA members and \$59 for non-members.
